

# LEAF NET

## TWO-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY, ONE YEAR FULL

The manufacturer warrants to the original purchaser of the Leaf Net that the company *will repair or replace* any cover where the fabric deteriorates or an open seam becomes apparent within ONE (1) year of purchase. After the initial one-year period, upon prepaid return of the cover by the owner, the manufacturer will replace with a new cover as per the prorated provisions shown below. All replaced covers will be returned at the homeowner's expense.



### THE PRORATED BASIS FOR COVER REPLACEMENT IS AS FOLLOWS:

IN THE FIRST YEAR: Unconditional on fabric deterioration and seams.  
REPLACEMENT CHARGE - 2nd year: 70% of current dealer suggested list price.

Excessive abrasion or grommets pulling out are specifically excluded from this warranty. Although any warranties implied are limited to the stated period after the date sold to the original purchaser, some states and/or provinces do not allow limitations on the length of time of an implied warranty. Therefore, the above may not apply in such states and/or provinces. Any claimant under this warranty has specific legal rights and the provisions in the warranty are neither a modification nor subtraction, but rather, an addition to the statutory warranties and other rights and remedies contained in the applicable state or provincial legislation. Manufacturer will not be liable for any incidental or consequential damages resulting from any defects in workmanship or material. Some states and/or provinces do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, therefore the foregoing limitation or exclusion may not apply. This warranty gives the original consumer purchaser specific legal rights. The purchaser also has implied warranty rights. In the event of a problem with warranty service or performance, you may be able to go to a small claims court, a state court or a federal district court.

### TO FILE A CLAIM

1. Please call 1-800-448-2343 between the hours of 8:30am - 5:00pm standard time Monday - Friday.
2. Please allow 4 - 6 weeks for warranty claims to be settled.

**All warranty claims must be handled directly with the manufacturer.  
Do not return cover to your dealer.**

# OWNER'S INSTRUCTIONS / LEAF NET

## LEAF NET INSTRUCTIONS: IN-GROUND

1. Lay the leaf net over the pool during summer months, loosely securing it with water bags, or rope tied between the grommets and tent pegs driven into the ground. The leaf net will keep leaves and other debris out of the pool, or off of the solar blanket.
2. For winter use, lay the leaf net loosely over the winter cover and tuck it under the water bags. Remove it once the autumn leaves have fallen to assure that they do not decay and slip through the net during the winter and spring.

## LEAF NET INSTALLATION: ABOVE-GROUND

1. Lay the leaf net over the pool, solar blanket or the winter cover. Weave the rope through the loops or grommets and tighten using the enclosed rope clinch.
2. For winter use, the leaf net should be removed once the autumn leaves have fallen.

## LEAF NET CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care in handling, storing and maintaining your leaf net will prolong its useful life.

1. **Do not** use abrasive materials such as concrete blocks, bricks or boards to hold a leaf net down.
2. **Do not** remove leaves or debris from the leaf net with a sharp object such as a rake.
3. **Do not** install a leaf net without padding sharp corners, decking, protrusions, rough edges of the coping, etc.

### DIRECTIONS FOR A "ROPE CLINCH"

- Step 1. Place both ends of rope through hole "1"
- Step 2. Place each end through hole "2" in the opposite direction.
- Step 3. Clinch each end in respective slot "3".
- Step 4. Tie the ends of the rope together.
